MS365



MC is a 'Microsoft 365 School'

- This means we use Microsoft 365 for our email, documents, files and communication.
- MS365 is great because you can login to your account on any device that has an internet connection, at home or school (and even in other countries!).
- We prefer to use Chrome to access the internet.
- All students have free access to the full MS365 suite













Logins and passwords



You have two types of credentials:

EduPass credentials:

- Login: @schools.vic.edu.au email
- Password set by the school

Use for MS365 (including email, etc.)

Maribyrnong College credentials

- Login: student code (eg MAC0034)
- Password set by the school

Use for Compass



- 1. Open up Chrome
- 2. Go to https://microsoft365.com/
- 3. Login using your EduPass Credentials
- 4. Go to the 'nine dots' menu and select Outlook







5. Send an email to your Maths teacher.

Tell him/her your favourite fruit.

- Make sure you write a greeting.
- Use proper spelling and punctuation.
- Sign off appropriately.

Example: Dear Mr Keenan,

Cherries are my favourite fruit.

Regards, Ms Mackenzie

One Drive



- Every student and staff member has their own One Drive, a storage space for documents and files in the cloud.
- You should keep all your computer-based school work in One Drive.






1. Go to the 'nine dots' menu and select One Drive

5. Name the file and share it with your Maths teacher




 Change password to make it the same as your school email address.




At MC, we use Compass for:


